- Responsible for all aspects of the productions of guerilla classics (schedules, riders, Visas, travels, insurance, ticketing, SUISA etc.)
- Day to day relationship management
- Responsibility for Care & Community Management

Content Research & Communication (~30%)

Tasks:

- Actively design and coordinate in-depth coverage of guerilla classics productions. This includes collaboration and networking with various experts (artists, writers, filmmakers etc.)
- Responsible for guerilla classics communication and PR
- Producing texts
- Researching content around the productions of guerilla classics

Skills:

- Knowledge of and passion for music and the arts
- Excellent writing skills in English or German
- Access to a network of different expert writers, who have know-how in the different art scenes (in Switzerland and abroad)
- Communication expertise (Social Media etc.)
- Knowledge in PR and journalism
- Strategic and creative thinking
- Interested in informing themselves about current events, project based experiences, philosophies etc.
- Based in Zurich or surrounding region
